Goetz-Ulf Jungmichel honored with the ANA Presidential Award

Berlin, August 26, 2025 – At this year's World's Fair of Money, held from August 19 to 23, 2025 in Oklahoma City, Goetz-Ulf Jungmichel, Managing Director of the World Money Fair Berlin, was awarded the prestigious Presidential Award of the American Numismatic Association (ANA). The official presentation took place on August 21, 2025, during the international Coin of the Year (COTY) Awards, which are among the most important honors in the field of coins and medallic art worldwide.

Uram, the 63rd President of the American Numismatic Association (ANA), in recognition of Jungmichel's outstanding commitment and dedication to the numismatic community. The World Money Fair will take place from Thursday, January 29 to Saturday, January 31, 2026, at the Estrel Congress Center in Berlin, celebrating "20 Years" of success at the Berlin exhibition venue.

The World Money Fair is the world's largest coin fair, held annually in Berlin at the end of January/beginning of February. It is the most important event in the international coin industry. Dealers, accessory suppliers, and auction houses from all over the world present their numismatic assortment to collectors, while state mints and private minting facilities showcase their latest products. In the technology section, a wide variety of machine manufacturers and suppliers to the coin industry meet and showcase the entire manufacturing process for coins and medals, from blank production and minting to packaging and the corresponding tool technology. The World Money Fair has continued to evolve since January 1972, when it was first held in Switzerland as the "International Coin Exchange." Today, during the three-day fair, which has been held in Berlin since 2006, more than 300 exhibitors, including mints and national banks from around 50 countries, present their products and services on 9,000 square meters of exhibition space at the Estrel Congress Center. The World Money Fair also offers investors an excellent opportunity to learn about physical precious metals and their significance as an investment. The exhibition includes coins from numerous countries, special mintings, and high-quality commemorative coins, as well as special exhibition editions and various commemorative coins.
